


Highlights

Tsinghua SEM-supported Journal of Marketing Science debuts

On August 21, 2021, a ceremonious seminar was held to mark the publication of the *Journal of Marketing Science's* maiden issue. The journal is academically supervised by Tsinghua University School of Economics and Management, Peking University's Guanghua School of Management, and the Chinese Marketing Association of Universities, and it is published by Posts & Telecom Press Co., Ltd. Its editorial committee is made up of more than 60 leading marketing scholars from over 40 well-known higher-educational institutions.

National Natural Science Foundation approves grants for multiple Tsinghua SEM projects

In August 2021, the National Natural Science Foundation of China announced the projects it had decided to support for the year 2021. Thirteen of the projects were from Tsinghua SEM. Of them, eight were recognized as general projects to be supported by the National Natural Science Fund, while two would be supported by the Young Scientists Fund.



Tsinghua SEM professor wins Sun Yefang Award

Professor QIAN Yingyi from the Department of Economics of Tsinghua SEM, who was also a Distinguished Professor of Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences and the dean of the school from 2006 to 2018, received the 19th Sun Yefang Award in Economic Sciences for his paper "Government and the Rule of Law".

The Sun Yefang Award is considered one of China's highest and most prestigious honors in the field of economics. Established in 1984, the award is given out biennially to economists who have made outstanding contributions to the theory of economics.



Tsinghua SEM professors win NationalExcellent Textbooks prize

The textbook *Econometrics* (5th edition), edited by LI Zinai and PAN Wenqing, professors of Tsinghua SEM, won a National Excellent Textbook first prize in the higher education category.

The National Textbook Commission of China launched the National Textbook Construction Awards, which are the highest honor in the field of textbook authorship. They demonstrate the textbook strategy's talent development achievements, can enhance a sense of honor and responsibility in textbook authors, and will help China establish a world-class textbook system with Chinese characteristics.

Tsinghua SEM Advisory Boardholds 2021 meeting

Tsinghua SEM held its 2021 Advisory Board Meeting on October 19, 2021. It was the board's 22nd annual meeting since its establishment. Forty-one board members, including 34 foreign members took part in the meeting. Some participated in person, while others took part virtually.

ZHU Rongji, founding dean of Tsinghua SEM, honorary chairman of Tsinghua SEM Advisory Board, former member of the Standing Committee of the Political Bureau of the Communist Party of China Central Committee and former Premier of the State Council, sent a letter in response to the report on work related to the meeting.

Chinese Vice President WANG Qishan met with members of the Tsinghua SEM Advisory Board in Beijing via a video link on October 20. MA Kai, former Chinese Vice Premier of the State Council, also attended the meeting.

Tsinghua holds the 11th GreatIdeas Innovation Challenge

The finals of the 11th Tsinghua University Great Ideas Innovation Challenge and 2022 Tsinghua University Creative Challenge (Freshmen session) were held at Tsinghua SEM on October 17, 2021. Focusing on "looking for ideas to advance social development," the competition sought out great ideas that could create value and aid the sustainable development of human society. The "Cool, easy-to-park, changeable, locking, foldable handlebars" team won the championship of the challenge.



Tsinghua SEM's ECO Explorer program kicks off

On December 9, 2021, Tsinghua SEM started the first edition of its ECO Explorer program. Forty-eight people from 20 Chinese provinces enrolled in the program. They were general managers of enterprises in the sectors of energy, chemical production, steel manufacturing, cement production, and environmental production, among other carbon-related industries. More than 20 of them were in charge of some of the top 500 private companies in China

The ECO Explorer program aims to help China to achieve its carbon peaking and carbon neutrality goals and implement Tsinghua University's carbon neutrality strategy. It will pool pioneering entrepreneurs of China and Tsinghua's academic resources, and try to develop into a high-quality industry-university-research platform. It will help facilitate research and application of carbon neutrality-related technologies and contribute to the development of the economy and society.



Tsinghua SEM-helmed journal included in Scopus

On January 13, 2022, the *China Journal of Economics (CJE)* got approval from Scopus Content Selection and Advisory Board to be included in the Scopus database. CJE is published by Tsinghua University Press under the direction of Tsinghua SEM

The first issue of *CJE* was published in 2014. In 2019, CJE became a Chinese Social Sciences Citation Index (CSSCI) extended source journal. Two years later, it was officially included in the CSSCI. For *CJE*, being included in the prestigious Scopus database was a milestone, affirming that its academic standard and influence had been recognized by the international academic society.

Tsinghua SEM professor selected as Distinguished Professor of Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences

On January 11, 2022, Tsinghua University held a symposium where certificates were awarded to the second group of Distinguished Professor of Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences.

CHEN Guoqing from Tsinghua SEM, WANG Hongjian and LU Xiaobo from the Academy of Arts & Design, ZHANG Guogang from the School of Humanities, and ZHANG Mingkai from the School of Law received the certificates.

Distinguished Professor of Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences is the highest academic honor that a Tsinghua professor can receive in the fields of philosophy and social sciences

Tsinghua SEM retains AACSB accreditation

On February 5, 2022, Tsinghua SEM was notified by the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB) that the Peer Review Team's recommendation for extension of business accreditation of the school has been approved by the Continuous Improvement Review Committee and the Board of Directors of AACSB International. Tsinghua SEM was the first business school on the Chinese mainland to obtain AACSB accreditation in April 2007 and has successfully maintained this label in 2012, 2017, and 2022.



Tsinghua SEM co-organizesdigital economy seminar

On March 20, 2022, a seminar co-organized by Tsinghua SEM and Tsinghua's School of Social Sciences was held to discuss how to develop talent for the digital economy. The seminar aimed to implement a strategy decided by the Central Committee of the Communist Party of China and the State Council, find ways to better facilitate the national development, and address the opportunities and challenges created by the digital economy. Experts from higher-educational institutions and organizations discussed how to develop talent for the digital economy, and the current status and outlook of the digital economy.

Seven Tsinghua SEM professors designated by Elsevier as Highly Cited Chinese Researchers

On April 14, 2022, Elsevier, an academic publishing company, published its list of the 2021 Highly Cited Chinese Researchers, which included seven professors from Tsinghua SEM.

BAI Chong-En, dean of Tsinghua SEM, and a Mansfield Freeman Chair Professor from the Department of Economics was selected for the applied economics category; Steven White, an associate professor from the Department of Innovation. Entrepreneurship and Strategy for the business administration category: CHEN Jian, a Lenovo Chair Professor from the Department of Management Science and Engineering for the management science and engineering category; CHEN Yubo, a professor from the Department of Marketing and secretary of the Party Committee of Tsinghua SEM for the business administration category; LI Ning, a Flextronics Chair Professor from the Department of Leadership and Organization Management for the business administration category: QIAN Yingyi, a professor from the Department of Economics and Distinguished Professor of Arts. Humanities and Social Sciences for the theoretical economics category; and SU Liangjun, a C. V. Starr Chair Professor from the Department of Economics for the theoretical economics category.

Tsinghua launches technologicalinnovation-themed MBA program

On April 16, 2022, Tsinghua University held a press conference in Beijing and Shenzhen to launch an MBA program for encouraging technological innovation.

Tsinghua SEM will be responsible for offering courses for the program. It will use its 30 years of experience in MBA education and rich faculty and industry expert resources to develop future leaders who will understand digital finance, be well-versed in technology, and be eager to innovate. It will combine the teaching of management theory with practice to train its students. The MBA program will focus on encouraging technological innovation, help build the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area and transform Shenzhen into a demonstration area of socialism with Chinese characteristics. It will aim to train high-quality talent that will help deepen China's reform and innovation and build a high-standard platform for opening up.



Global Hybrid Classroom CertificateProgram launched

To integrate systematic curriculum resources, encourage
Tsinghua students to communicate with the outside world,
and attract more talent from different fields worldwide,
Tsinghua University has launched the Global Hybrid
Classroom Certificate Program, which includes three courses
for undergraduates and seven courses for graduate students.
Tsinghua SEM offers two courses for undergraduate students
on applied economics and finance and another one for
graduate students on finance.

Tsinghua SEM wins big at MaYuehan Cup sports meet

On April 24, 2022, Tsinghua University held the 65th Ma Yuehan Cup Track and Field Competition, marking the end of the year-long Ma Yuehan Cup sports events. Tsinghua SEM emerged as a big winner. It was ranked fourth in Group A in terms of team score in the overall Ma Yuehan Cup sports events. At the track and field competition, its total team score came in third in Group A, with the women's team winning first place and the men's team sixth place. Its women's volleyball, beach volleyball, 5 vs. 5 basketball, and 3 vs. 3 basketball teams all won championships. Tsinghua SEM took first place in the badminton and orienteering contests. It attained all the top accolades for acrobatic gymnastics: the highest score in Group A, first place in both standard and free cheerleading routines, and the prize for the best performance.

Virtual event held to celebrateTsinghua SEM's 38th anniversary

On April 23, 2022, Tsinghua SEM held a virtual event to celebrate its 38th anniversary and Tsinghua University's 111th anniversary. It was an open course for Tsinghua alumni, offered by BAI Chong-En, dean of Tsinghua SEM and president of the Tsinghua SEM Alumni Association. Professor BAI talked about some of the major theoretical and practice issues that China now faces.

Tsinghua SEM signs cooperation agreementwith Qiuzhen College on doctoral programs

On July 11, 2022, Tsinghua SEM signed a cooperation agreement with Qiuzhen College on doctoral programs, which aims to make full use of Tsinghua's teaching and academic resources and develop leading interdisciplinary talents closely relevant to mathematics.

Tsinghua SEM offers virtual coursesin Global Summer Program

From May 23 to 27, 2022, Tsinghua SEM offered virtual courses in a global summer program to students from all over the world. Over the five-day period, more than 400 students from 37 universities and colleges in ten countries and regions took the courses. They were from Harvard University, Yale University, Columbia University, Cornell University, the Johns Hopkins University, Imperial College London, the London School of Economics and Political Science, University College London, Nanyang Technological University, and the National University of Singapore, among some other prestigious universities. They were undergraduate or graduate students, and some were on MBA or EMBA programs.

Party branches of three businessschools study XI Jinping's speeches

On May 24, 2022, the Party branches of Tsinghua University School of Economics and Management, Peking University's Guanghua School of Management, and Renmin University of China's Business School held a virtual event to study the speeches that XI Jinping, general secretary of the Communist Party of China Central Committee, made to celebrate the 100th anniversary of the founding of the Communist Youth League of China, and during his inspection trips to the tree universities.

Tsinghua SEM holds 2022 commencement

On June 26, 2022, Tsinghua SEM held a commencement for its 2022 graduates. The ceremony was emceed by Dean BAI Chong-En. Dr. Shing-Tung YAU delivered a keynote speech. Dr. YAU is a member of the United States National Academy of Sciences and the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, and a foreign member of the Chinese Academy of Sciences, the Russian Academy of Sciences, and Academia Sinica of Taiwan. He is a tenured professor from Harvard University's departments of mathematics and physics. He is also a chair professor at Tsinghua University, the director of Tsinghua's Yau Mathematical Sciences Center, the dean of Tsinghua's Qiuzhen College, and the president of the Yanqi Lake Beijing Institute of Mathematical Sciences and Applications.

The 2021–2022 academic year saw 1,507 students graduate from Tsinghua SEM, of whom 239 got their bachelor's degrees, 295 their second bachelor's degrees, four their bachelor's degrees with a minor, 906 their master's degrees (including MBA and EMBA programs), and 63 their doctorate degrees.

Our undergraduate program has a triangular training model focusing on value shaping, ability cultivation, and knowledge transmission. We always prioritize value shaping since the fundament of education is creating virtuous people. In 2019, the school continually optimized the general education course system, adding "Computer Intelligence and Data Science" as a compulsory course. In 2021, we further optimized our general education curriculum with five core-competence

course categories including: civilizations; societies; aesthetics and creativity; scientific thinking; and critical thinking, communication, and leadership. In 2020, we welcomed our first Computer Science and Finance double major program student; In 2021, we welcomed our first Tsinghua-CUHK Economics double major program student; In 2022, we will be welcoming our first Tsinghua Xuetang Economics Program students together with the School of Social Sciences.



Our Ph.D. program utilizes Tsinghua's leading subjects to provide the government and universities with top researchers in the field of economics and management. We also contribute teachers to global top universities. Our program focuses on improving the quality of our Ph.D. education, building a comprehensive Ph.D. education system, and reinforcing our education value throughout the program.

In 2021, many of our Ph.D. graduates took office in top universities including, the University of Science and Technology of China, Harbin Institution of Technology, Sun Yat-sen University, Southern University of Science and Technology, and Hunan University. Besides an academic career, many of them have chosen a governmental path working in public sectors like the National Development and Reform Commission, China Securities Regulatory Commission, Guangxi Government, and Beijing Government. In 2021, CHEN Zhanguang Ph.D. from the accounting department class of 2021, and LI Tao from the Science Management and Engineering department class of 2021 were awarded the Sliver and the Bronze Tsinghua University Graduate Student Qihang Prize.







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Master's Programs

The Master's programs cultivate the most talented domestic and international students, continuously increase influence and promote internationalization. Full-time Master's programs attract elite students by exam-free recommendation mechanism. With the applicants of 2021 coming from 43 countries and regions, the programs have sustained a year-by-year increase in international applications as well as application-to-enrollment rate. The quality of students admitted to Tsinghua MCFO Master's Program of Accounting has also been steadily improved.

The year 2021 and 2022 have witnessed great achievements in all Master's programs.

As for talent cultivation, the cooperation with the Advisory Board has been enhanced. Master in Management program (MiM) has maintained its business projects cooperation with McKinsey and

Budweiser APAC for the third year. Master of Finance program [MoF] has provided financial practice classes with STARR for the second year. Tsinghua-Columbia Dual Master's Degree Program in Business Analytics (TCMiBA) has enhanced its cooperation with SAP, and Tsinghua MCFO Master's Program of Accounting has recruited 19 industry tutors to teach students in top companies. Facing COVID-19 pandemic, Master's programs have adjusted and optimized the academic schedules in collaboration with international partners, continuously improving their global influence. In the Masters in Management Rankings 2021 by Financial Times, Tsinghua SEM ranked No. 20 in the world and No. 1 in Asia. Master of Finance program of Tsinghua SEM ranks No. 7 in the world and No.1 in Asia in the Financial Times 2022 Global Masters in Finance (pre-experience)

Executive Education Programs

Following the strategic decision made by the central government to achieve carbon peak and carbon neutrality and in order to implement Tsinghua University's own carbon neutrality strategy, the Center for Executive Education of Tsinghua School of Economics and Management (hereinafter referred to as the Center) launched China's first double carbon training program-"China Eco-Explorer Program". This program brings together Chinese entrepreneurs with social responsibility, pioneering spirit and a large mindedness to collaborate with first-class disciplines of Tsinghua University to explore new systems, new paths, new industries, new technologies and new businesses based on low-carbon and sustainable development. Entrusted by the Central Organization Department and China's Stateowned Assets Supervision and Administration Commission (SASAC), the fifth session of the "Central Enterprise Executive Management Training Program"has been successfully organized by the Center. Like all previous sessions, the fifth session was positively reviewed by the participants and the departments they are affiliated with.

The Center has made great efforts to develop online courses, launching "Tsinghua Professional Courses in Economics and Management", and organizing online courses in combination with "School of Economics and Management Elite Certificate Program" for several state-owned enterprises. In addition, the Center has launched the first online open enrollment program taught in English for global executives since its establishment. It is committed to telling China's stories, spreading China's voice and promoting non-governmental diplomacy. Furthermore, the Center actively coordinates with the campus in Shenzhen and the Greater Bay Area to better connect the School with the local business community, facilitating the latter's strategic transformation by offering its members new ideas for survival and development.

Tsinghua x-lab

Over the past nine years since its establishment, Tsinghua x-lab has explored in various ways and gradually established a feasible and structured education system based on creativity, innovation, and entrepreneurship. It has expanded its educational resources through a series of activities including workshops, seminars and challenging competitions.

The 11th "Tsinghua University Great Ideas Innovation Challenge (Freshmen session)" final was successfully held on October 17, 2021. The competition inspired students to pay attention to society, identify problems and come up with great ideas, with 57 freshmen teams signing up and demonstrating their creativity on the university stage. Focusing on the 17 United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals, the third "SDG Open Hack @ Tsinghua University" final was successfully held on December 31, 2021. During the competition, over 170 solutions were generated by more than 900 innovators in the hopes of achieving the sustainable development goals.

To further encourage Tsinghua students' innovation and entrepreneurial enthusiasm, and to strengthen the industry-university cooperation, as well as to promote the continuous development of scientific and technological innovation, Tsinghua

x-lab & Kunshan Huaqiao "Innovation For Future" Innovation and Entrepreneurship Competition final was successfully held on November 30, 2021. The competition attracted 28 Tsinghua startup teams to participate.

The sixth TIE² (Tsinghua TUM International Innovation Entrepreneurship Exchange) was successfully held online from November 8 to 12, 2021 with the theme of "Deep Tech". Seven outstanding Tsinghua start-up teams with the intentions of expanding their projects to the international market were selected to participate in this program. Featuring online lectures, workshops, mentoring and networking sessions, the program sought to broaden the students' international vision and enhance their innovation skills.

The ninth "Tsinghua University President's Innovation Challenge" kicked off on April 16, 2022, with the goals of developing and refining the entrepreneurial leadership skills of Tsinghua students. The competition attracted 96 Tsinghua start-up teams to participate in various sectors, including information technology, energy and environment, education, healthcare, hardware and manufacturing and so on.


